The Goshen High School Music Department has a rich tradition of excellence. It offers a wide variety of performance opportunities for all levels of interest and ability. Currently, performing organizations include:

Band: Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band, Advanced Crimson Jazz Ensemble, Crimson Jazz Ensemble, Crimson Marching Band, Crimson Percussion Ensemble, Color Guard, and two Pep Bands

Choir: Advanced Crimson Choir, Advanced Crimson Chorale, Crimson Choir, Crimson Chorus, Men's Crimson Choir, and Crimsonaires

Orchestra: Symphonic Orchestra, Crimson Concert Orchestra, Philharmonic Orchestra, Camerata Chamber Orchestra, and Red Wire Strings

We also continue to have exciting and enriching beginning ensembles at Goshen Junior High School and Goshen Intermediate School in band, choir, and orchestra for 6th-8th grade students.

The music department offers non-performance opportunities in applied music studies, IB Music, and guitar classes.

Our organizations receive superior ratings in all music events and our music program is ranked among the finest in the state. Goshen High School has been one of the only schools in the state of Indiana to be state-ranked in Concert Band, Marching Band, Orchestra, and Choir. There are over 1,000 students participating in the music program from 6-12th grades.

The music department also presents a spring musical as a collaboration with band, choir, orchestra, and theatre students.
